

Cookies Policies

Like most large websites, so that our site may run correctly, occasionally we install in your computer or mobile device small files named cookies.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website installs in your computer or mobile device when you visit it. These files allow a web site “to remember” your actions and preferences during a certain period of time, namely username, language of choice, characters size and other display settings. That is why when you scroll a web site or return to a site you’ve already visited, normally, you don’t have to indicate your preferences again.

How do we use cookies?

We use strictly necessary cookies: allow users to browse the site and use its applications, as well as access the site’s access areas. Without these cookies the services required can’t be provided.

- Analytical Cookies: used to create and analyse statistics, in order to improve this site operation.
- Functionality Cookies: keep the user’s preferences regarding the site use, so that is not necessary to configure the site every time you visit it.

How to control cookies

You may control and/or erase the cookies you want. For further information, visit aboutcookies.org. You may erase all cookies already installed in your computer or mobile device or activate an available option in most internet browsers that prevent its installation. But if you do so, you may have to configure manually some preferences whenever you visit the site, with the risk of deactivating some services and features.
